<b>dalmore 12 year old (highland)</b>	40%	£8.00
<i>Silky toffee with malt and vanilla, a wave or two of sweet liquorice adds further richness.</i>		
<b>dalmore gran reserve (highland)</b>	40%	£9.00
<i>Dried fruits with soft sherry tones. Strong malt and christmas cake. Roasted coffee and chocolate.</i>		
<b>dalmore 15 year old (highland)</b>	40%	£10.00
<i>Sweet vanilla with aromatic cloves, cinnamon and ginger. Seville oranges, lemons and limes.</i>		

**glenmorangie original (highland) 40% £7.00**  
*Velvet textured with delicate, honeyed overtones with citrus, softening into vanilla and almonds.*

**glenmorangie lasanta (highland) 46% £8.00**  
*A luscious caramel nose and a chewy, velvety body with hints of the sherry cask.*

**glenmorangie quinta ruban (highland) 46% £8.00**  
*A rich, cherry-chocolate-tannin dram with a hint of mint.*

**glenmorangie nectar d'òr (highland) 46% £9.00**  
*A lot of fructose, ripe apricots, icing sugar, hints of kiwis, tangerines.*

**glenmorangie 18 year old (highland) 43% £14.00**  
*Melting honey and aromatic florals. Rich, sticky date and fig flavours with a caress of woodsmoke.*

**glenmorangie quarter century (highland) 43% £28.00**  
*Intense warmth, heady with brambles and spices that melts softly away for a lingering finish.*

**royal lochnagar 12 year old (highland) 40% £7.00**  
*Caiky, sherryish, sultanas with a malty, grassy, sweetness.*

**blair athol 12 year old (highland) 43% £7.00**  
*Smoky, rooty, treacly. Impeccable balance between sweetness and dryness.*

**dalwhinnie 15 year old (highland) 43% £7.00**  
*A big, crisp, dry and very aromatic nose with hints of heather and peat.*

**clynelish 14 year old (coastal highland) 46% £7.00**  
*Creamy maltiness. Big flavours. Peaty. Seaweedy-fruity.*

**oban 14 year old (west highland) 43% £7.00**  
*Rich sweetness and fruits - oranges, lemons and pears, with sea-salt and peaty smokiness.*

**glenkinchie 10 year old (lowland) 43% £7.00**  
*Soft, spicy: cinnamon and, ginger. Beautiful balance of sweetness and dryness.*

**bladnoch 10 year old (lowland) 43% £7.00**  
*Sweet. Spicy. Muscovado sugar. Digestive biscuits.*

**rosebank 1991 14 year old (lowland) 46% £10.00**  
*Christmas cake, figs and earl grey tea, getting pleasantly spicy (spices for mulled wine, Chinese anise, cinnamon, cloves).*

**ardbeg 10 year old (islay) 46% £7.00**

*An immediate waft of peat smoke. Full, robustly flavoured with turf and lapsang souchong tea.*

**ardbeg uigeadail (islay) 54.2% £9.00**

*Sweet yet pungently smoky: lime marmalade and peat fires, malt, cocoa powder, salted herring.*

**ardbeg 1990 airigh nam beist (islay) 46% £10.00**

*Smoky, ice cream, fennel, pine nuts and zesty limes.*

**ardbeg renaissance (islay) 55.9% £10.00**

*Peat soaked in vibrant tropical juices. Toasted vanilla and sizzling cinnamon escape into the atmosphere with sherbet space dust and smooth Swiss chocolate spheres.*

**laphroaig 10 year old (islay) 40% £7.00**

*Phenolic, seaweedy, with a hint of estery, melony, sweetness.*

**caol ila 12 year old (islay) 43% £7.00**

*Rounded, mid-weight. Good smoky intensity mid-palate. Clean juicy fruits, oil and dry smoke.*

**lagavulin 16 year old (islay) 43% £8.00**

*Dry peat smoke with a gentle but strong sweetness, followed by sea and salt with touches of wood.*

**highland park 12 year old (orkney) 40% £7.00**

*Smoky, "garden bonfire" sweetness, heathery, malty, hint of sherry.*

**highland park 18 year old (orkney) 43% £11.00**

*Warm, notably flowery. Heather-honey, fresh oak, sap, peat, smoky fragrance.*

**talisker 10 year old (skye) 45.8% £7.00**

*Full maltiness, slightly syrupy, with sourness and a very big pepperiness developing.*

**isle of jura 10 year old (jura) 40% £7.00**

*Sweetish, soft, malty, oily, slowly developing a slight island dryness and saltiness.*

**isle of jura superstition (jura) 40% £8.00**

*Smooth. Waxy. Piney, honeyish. Developing sweet creaminess. Opens very slowly.*

**isle of jura 16 year old (jura) 40% £10.00**

*Fragrant, piney, a hint of the sea.*

## wales

**penderyn 46% £8.00**

*Smooth and fairly sweet. Vanilla, lemon and currant. Clean and gentle.*

**penderyn peated 46% £8.00**

*Sweet and light. Smoky. Green fruit. Kiwi. Very pleasant flowing feel.*

## japan

abv 50ml

**suntory yamazaki 10 year old 40% £7.00**

*Dry fruits, malt, spicy, cinnamon, vanilla*

**suntory hakushu 12 year old 43.5% £8.00**

*Sweet lime, green fruits then a hint of smoke and a buttery meadow sweet/chamomile note.*

**nikka yoichi 10 year old 45% £10.00**

*A clean fresh fragrance with notes of peat, light smoke and spice.*

## *pot and coffey still malt*

**nikka all malt 40% £7.00**

*Creamy, toffee with a light and crisp finish. Very clean.*

## **single grain whisky**

**cameron brig 40% £6.00**

*Faintly coffeish. Smoky. With a slight, appetising, bitterness.*

## **blended malt whisky**

**monkey shoulder 40% £7.00**

*Ripe, very sweet and long. Toasted/polished oak, light resin notes, nutmeg.*

**compass box the peat monster 46% £7.00**

*Sea salt, kelp, lemon cheesecake, a cloud of peat, peaches or nectarines, firesmoke.*

**johnnie walker green label 15 year old 40% £7.00**

*Sweet, Honey, Brown Sugar, Smoke*

**jon, mark and robbo's the rich spicy one 40% £7.00**

*Rounded and honeyed. Balanced grip mid-palate walnuts and caramelised fruits. Chewy.*

**jon, mark and robbo's the smooth sweeter one 40% £7.00**

*Medium. Balanced. Some burnt pastry. Vanilla? Young oak. A hint of menthol.*

**jon, mark and robbo's the smokey peaty one 40% £7.00**

*Cedary. Logs on the fire. Embers. Sweet grass. Vegetal. Vanilla.*

**serendipity 12 year old 40% £10.00**

*Sweetness comes off first, bourbony vanilla, peat and chocolate.*

**johnnie walker black label 12 year old 40% £6.00**

*Rich. Maple syrup, spices and mustard. Can a whisky have a hint of acidity on the nose?*

**johnnie walker gold label 18 year old 40% £10.00**

*Hugely silky and ripe: a whiff of smoke, peach, mango. All very rich, waxy and long.*

**johnnie walker blue label 40% £20.00**

*Beautifully rounded. Voluptuous. Ginger cake. Marzipan. Nuts. Pears in chocolate.*

*justerini + brooks rare 40% £6.00*

*Light, but firm. Sweet, like biting into a raspberry-jam tart. Then blackberries and passion-fruit*

**bailie nicol jarvie 40% £6.00**

*Marshmallow maltiness, rose-water, then cedary, briar-like dryness.*

**compass box asyla 40% £6.00**

*Some creamy vanilla, light fruitiness with a bitter/dry finish.*

**chivas regal 12 year old 40% £6.00**

*Pancakes with cream. Orangey. Buttercups. Herbal.*

**chivas regal 18 year old 40% £8.00**

*Oily, nearly viscous. Dried apricot. Roasted pinenuts. Candied chestnut. Toffee, mocha ice cream.*

**chivas revolve 40% £10.00**

**whyte and mackay 22 year old 43% £11.00**

*overripe banana, raspberry, cocoa powder and with water, raisin bread, pulpy fruits and lemon tart.*

## irish whiskey

abv 50ml

**jameson 40% £6.00**

*Very aromatic. Waxy orange skins. Linseed oil. Leather.*

**powers 40% £6.00**

*Spicy creaminess, a full flavoured finish with a touch of fruit and honey.*

**black bush 40% £6.00**

*Long, spicy and grapefruity with some toasty, oaky notes.*

**bushmills malt 10 year old 40% £7.00**

*Toasted almonds, raisins, slightly burnt toffee.*

**bushmills malt triple wood 16 year old 40% £10.00**

*Round and rich. Sweet dried fruits, brazil nut, coffee, soft malt, popcorn. Good grip. Oak in balance.*

**redbreast 12 year old pure pot still 40% £7.00**

*Oily, some liquorice and enormous sweet-sour complexity. Spicy and long*

**green spot pure pot still 40% £7.00**

*Oily linseed cooled by strains of gentle menthol, joined by some spiciness towards the end.*

## bourbon, american, canadian + rye whiskey

abv 50ml

**wild turkey 8 year old 50.5% £5.00**

*Ripe, treacle, chocolate mousse, with a lift of rose petal/violet*

**wild turkey rare breed single barrel 54.2% £8.00**

*Gorgeous honey, diced dates, old leather and rye with a teasing sprinkling of spice.*

**jack daniel's 40% £5.00**

*A smooth dry style overlaid with caramel and liquorice notes.*

**jack daniel's gentleman jack 40% £7.00**

*A dry kick off, swiftly develops a lovely, clingy sweetness, and that ever-present liquorice.*

**jack daniel's single barrel 45% £8.00**

*Almost stiffly phenolic: you can cut through the sweet roasty, oaky intensity.*

**jack daniel's silver select 50% £9.00**

*Drier, richer, more bourbon-like, more complex than any other Jack Daniels*

**bulleit 40% £5.00**

*Perfumed start: a whiff of dried lavender, singed orange peel, dusty spice cupboards.*

**jim beam black 8 year old 43% £6.00**

*Sweet-n-sour caramel and banana.*

**canadian club 40% £6.00**

*Sweet and sugary. Cane syrup with a hint of liquorice and barley sugar.*

**maker's mark 45% £6.00**

*Wheaty, nutty. Bananas? Buttered toast. Molasses. Maple syrup.*

**buffalo trace 45% £6.00**

*Smooth, creamy. Faintly smoky and tobacco-like.*

**crown royal 40% £6.00**

*Poached pear, peach, creamy toffee/sweet vanilla and hint of light rye notes, lemon and hickory.*

**knob creek 50% £6.00**

*Marshmallow maltiness. Develops smooth, satisfying, nutty, flavours. Hazelnuts.*

**woodford reserve 45.2% £6.00**

*Whole almonds, marzipan. Root ginger. A touch of fresh oak, and some charcoal.*

**mellow corn 50% £6.00**

*Rich and chewy, sweet at first with a soft pepper note.*

**elijah craig 12 year old 47% £6.00**

*Rye hits every corner of the mouth: light oils and myriad oaky, complex notes to the roof.*

**w.l. weller 12 year old 40% £6.00**

*Creamy, fudgy, flavours. Berry fruits emerging, then fruity, plum-skin acidity.*

**eagle rare single barrel 10 year old 45% £7.00**

*Smooth. Vanilla. Condensed milk. Coconut. Orange. Tropical fruits.*

**blanton's original 46.5% £8.00**

*Firm, smooth, spicy. Turkish delight. Dates. Cedar.*

**van winkle family reserve rye 13 year old 47.8% £8.00**

*Good viscosity. Sweetish. Spicy. Cinnamon. Nutmeg. Rich fruitcake.*

**pappy van winkle's family reserve 15 year old 53.5% £9.00**

*Mature. Inside of an old wardrobe. Leather. Date, chocolate, coffee, black cherry, cigar.*

**rittenhouse rye 50% £6.00**

*Maple syrup, pine tree, viscous with the rye shining through*

**sazerac rye 6 year old 45% £7.00**

*Rye spiciness with an overlay of sweet malt, cinnamon, faint sichuan pepper, a whisper of clove.*

**old potrero malted rye 2 year old 62.2% £10.00**

*Strong cinnamon notes come through, as well as a distinct floral tone. Just a touch of leather.*
